Approval of the Director of School Education, Puducherry, is hereby conveyed to Achariya Bala Siksha Mandir School, Thengaithittu, Puducherry, for conducting classes from L.K.G to XII standard for the academic year 2024-2025 subject to fulfillment of the following condition within 3 months from the date of issue of this order.

1. Fresh Fire NOC is to be submitted.
2. Fresh Sanitary Certificate to be obtained and submitted.
3. Staff ECS payment acquittance should be submitted.
4. Reserve fund to be raised.
5. Rain water Harvesting Certificate to be produced.

The Management of the said school is informed that all the conditions prescribed in the Pondicherry School Education Rules, 1996 and The Puducherry Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011, should be satisfied failing which further continuance of recognition is liable to be rejected.

The Educational agency is informed that all the conditions as stipulated in the Annexure to this order should be fulfilled. The annexure to this order shall have the same effect as this order and shall be treated as part of the order.

1. The Educational agency should not withdraw or otherwise close the Endowment fund created in the name of the school, without the prior permission of the Director of School Education, Puducherry.
2. The management shall not appoint any teacher who does not possess the Educational and Professional qualifications prescribed in the Pondicherry School Education Act 1987, Pondicherry School Education Rules 1996.
3. The management shall not appoint any teacher whose Certificate has been suspended or cancelled or who had been declared unfit to be a teacher in recognized schools or who has been convicted for offences involving moral turpitudes.
4. After the financial year is over, the accounts of the school are to be audited by a chartered Accountant and a Certificate signed by the Auditor that the accounts have been audited, should be sent to the Director of School Education, Puducherry within a month after the completion of the audit.
5. The management should not run branch school on the strength of this order.
6. No other school or institution of any kind should function within the school compound.
7. The standards to which recognition has been granted should alone be displayed in the name board.
8. All students in X and XII should be allowed to appear for the X and XII Public Examinations in the same academic year. The Second - term (Half - Yearly) school examinations of X and XII should not be a 'Selection Examination' for the students to write the Public Examinations.
9. Transfer Certificate should not be issued to the students in the middle of an academic year without obtaining specific permission from the Inspecting Officer of the school concerned.
10. All general and professional Certificates of teaching and non-teaching staff should be available with the individuals only. Only attested copies thereof should be retained in the schools.
11. The original Fixed Deposit Bank receipts and bank passbook should be available in the school.
12. Transfer Certificates of School in respect of all students should be maintained in the school.
13. No donations other than the fees prescribed by the Department should be collected.
14. Lessons for 10th and 12th standards should not be taken up in the previous standards (viz. Ninth and Eleventh standards).
15. The above conditions should invariably be followed. Any violation of the condition will entail the management to withdraw the recognition.
16. The Educational agency is informed that the renewal of the Building License and Structural Stability Certificate for the school building should be obtained from the competent authorities from the date on which they expire. The Educational Agency is strictly informed that it should not run the school without valid Building License/ Structural Stability Certificate of the school building and the school management will be personally held responsible for any lapse in this regard.
17. The Educational Agency is informed that the Certificate that "the fire protection arrangements made in the building are in order" issued by the Competent Authority should be obtained.
18. The school which is granted recognition by the Directorate attains the status of a Recognized School and it shall have a duty to comply with the direction of the Department to serve the cause of public at all times, failing which it will stand to lose the status conferred by this Directorate.
19. Rainwater harvesting structure should be established in the school building and the open place like playground, garden etc., of the school.
