**HOW THIS DEED OF TRUST WITNESSETH:**

The **AUTHORS** of the Trust do hereby constitute a Public Charitable Trust with objects hereunder with an initial corpus fund of **Rs. 2,000/-** (Rupees Nine Thousand Only) as per the terms and conditions of the Trust set out hereunder:-

1. The name of the Trust shall be "**ACHARYA EDUCATIONAL PUBLIC TRUST**".

2. The Office of the Trust shall be **Mr. S. Venkatesh Nagar, Villianur, Pondicherry - 605 110**; or such other place/ places as may be decided by the Trustee/s from time to time.

3. The following shall be the objects of the Trust:-

(i) To provide and run School Education - Basic, elementary, Secondary, High Secondary, College Management research and training into charitable endowments or Trust including vocational education, Work experience etc.,

(ii) To provide Collegiate Education, Pre-Degree Courses, Integrated Course, Post Graduate Courses and Doctoral Programmes in Arts, Science, Medicine, Commerce, Social Sciences, Veterinary Science, Humanities, Social Work Education, Integrated Rural Development etc.,

(iii) To provide Adult and continuing Education, Non formal Education in all fields, Careers and professions in several areas including short term courses, evening colleges and part time Courses both at under graduate and post graduate levels.

4. To provide technical education programs through full time and part time courses at the diploma, Degree, Post-Graduate and Doctoral levels in all branches, specialities, disciplines of Engineering, Applied Sciences and Technology including Management Sciences, Distance Courses, evening Courses, short-term and non-formal courses and continuing education programs.

5. To provide industrial education, research and training at all levels, viz, Craftman, Technical, Professional and Post-Graduate levels, through part professional and sandwich courses, training before and after education and during vacations in various skills, arts and crafts as well as various trades and branches of Engineering, Technology, Industry, Commerce and Applied Arts, also including all other branches of education, skills and knowledge as set out, Agriculture, Horticulture, Sericulture, Forestry, Textiles, Industrial Design, Home Science, Dietetics and Nutrition etc.,

6. To provide ample opportunities for integrating the education and training with the needs of Socio-economic development, Social Service, Community service, Rural Development, Urban development and such other new disciplines and specialities through the establishment of Research and Training cum Production-Centres.

7. To provide Teacher Training Programs, Teacher Services and Courses for General Teaching, College/level Teaching and for teaching in Technical and Technological Institutions.

8. To provide job oriented education, training and work experience programmes including Earn While you Learn Schemes and such education and training so as to develop self employment and entrepreneurship.

9. To maintain, develop, improve and extend facilities available in the various institutions under the Trust and to introduce additional facilities as may be required for purpose of education, training, research and development in the various fields such as Education, Arts, Science, Medicine, Engineering, Technology, Textiles, Dietetics and Nutrition, Management Sciences, Veterinary Sciences, Industrial and Agricultural Productivity, Products and processes and to provide consultancy and technical assistance.

10. To accept the Autonomous status to any of the institutions in and when the University Grants Commission, University of Pondicherry, Madras Bharathidasan University Trichy and/or other competent authorities accord.

11. To provide for the dissemination of literary, Cultural, Scientific and Technical knowledge through educational and literary surveys, Publication of Journals, Magazines, Periodicals, newspapers, Books, Pamphlets in the regional languages (TAMIL) as well as in English and Hindi and to establish necessary facilities for printing and publication.

12. To undertake and promote research and development activities and Industry, Trade and commerce through the establishment of Research and Development centres and by extending technical and financial assistance to the existing R & D Centres functioning in Industries and educational institutions.

13. To encourage, undertake, promote and associate with integrated rural development and integrated urban development programmes and schemes including rural reconstruction programmes formulated in general conformity with similar policies and programmes adopted by Central Government/Union Territory of Pondicherry from time to time.

14. To provide free medical aid to the needy and deserving by establishing, maintaining and conducting primary health centres, maternity, and child welfare centres and hospitals.

15. To encourage and promote medical education, research and training including veterinary education and research and such other branches of medical and veterinary education through the establishment of Advanced Research/Training Centres/Institutions.

16. To encourage and promote interaction between Education and Industry.

17. To impart education and training at the Institutions and to afford help to such students as are poor and deserving by way of stipends, free scholarships, Research fellowships, Teacher-fellowships, Free boarding and lodging, Free gifts of books, teaching aids, instruments and equipments.

18. To establish, maintain, improve and extend the hostel facilities for the benefit of the students of the Institutions.

19. To promote awareness of traditional music of India amongst the general public and in particular the younger generation.

20. To conduct or sponsor performances of music, dance drama etc., and also exhibitions, Symposiums etc., in the field of fine arts.

21. To provide facilities to students and artistes to promote awareness and facilitate attainment of expertise in fine arts.

22. To provide a low cost/free facilities to the weaker section to learn the art of music.

23. To print and publish literature, records and create audio-visual materials of importance to the public and artistes.

24. To establish, maintain, improve or renovate and run existing or new College(s) for the training of musicians.

25. To associate with any other allied Institution-auxiliary-vented/projected groups that the Trustees may deem fit.

26. To arrange, give musical soirees, dance, dramas and promote the study of theory and practice of music in all its form and variety for entertainment or educational purposes.

27. To arrange for the writing, tape recording, making of records by any process whatsoever containing music lessons, music of every description on cassettes or otherwise.

28. To import, export, buy, sell and instruments of music, books, magazines for learning music and to do all other things which are incidental, auxiliary or conducive thereto.

29. For the furtherance of the objects enumerated above, to undertake, organize and facilitate conferences, Seminars, Study Courses, Training Programmes, lectures and workshops and similar other activities.

30. For the furtherance of the objects enumerated above, to maintain liaison with professional institutions and educational and training bodies in various parts of world.

31. To provide fees, books, equipments, Freshhips, and/or Scholarships to the deserving students.

32. To feed poor students and to start free student hostels and free hostels.

33. To help and assist poor and Hebrering people in marriage.

34. To conduct nutritional and health services.

To conduct/separate Programmes for providing nutritional assistance e.g. to operate a School/Lunch/Food programme for children, Operation nutritional supplement programme for needy women which shall be provided/conducted/distributed free of charge.

35. Testing of diets from nutritional view point.

To render assistance to poor patient by providing medicines etc., provisions of health care, preventive medical services (including dental services)

36. Assistance to Hospitals in setting up the various facilities such as Blood Bank, Eye Bank, Burn Centres, etc., for the poor patients.

37. Provision of outdoor dispensary or assistance thereof and also to run 'Mobile' medical services.

38. Conduct education in health care or provide assistance in the provision of primary health care education.

39. To provide monetary assistance and social services in case of natural calamities.

40. To render financial assistance to the poor and the disadvantaged.

41. To promote and advance social education, charity and general welfare of the people.

42. To render assistance to mentally retarded, crippled and other physically handicapped children, both directly and through institutions engaged in helping their rehabilitation through appropriate therapy, education, vocational training and other programmes.

43. To render assistance to orphans, indigent and other less-privileged children for their subsistence, shelter, education and medical care and to established social welfare institutions engaged in promoting these specific objectives.

44. To render assistance, both directly and through established social welfare organizations, for appropriate literacy, educational and vocational training programmes that will help rehabilitate women in distress, especially widows without any means of support and those neglected and ill-treated by their husbands or other members of the family and promote their vocational skills and self reliance.

45. To render assistance to aged and indigent men and women for treatment and medical care that they cannot otherwise afford.

46. To render assistance on a case-by-case basis which will, in the opinion of the Trustees, promote the welfare of the deprived members of the community, especially women and children.

47. To attend primarily to the needs of all children in India in particular and the children of all other countries in general without any distinction as to community, caste, race, sex, language or religion.

48. To strive for the health, welfare and upliftment of children.

49. To take all such steps as may be necessary for the upkeep, maintenance and welfare of children.

50. To educate or assist in the education of children and for this purpose take all steps for the formation of appropriate forum and institutions and to acquire lands and buildings or develop places dedicated to educational and cultural progress of children.

51. To render assistance, financial or otherwise, to all institutions or organisations (or even to individual cases of children) which help the progress of children directly or indirectly.

52. To strive for the amelioration of the conditions of weed eaters, destitute women and children with the primary object of saving and protecting children's life and interests.

- 33. To take up the rehabilitation of orphaned children, impoverished Mothers, irresponsible Fathers calculated to protect the well being of children.
- 34. To do all such work as are necessary to help children from "MDD TO DDD" (as it were).
- 35. To champion the case of children in distress.
- 36. To take such relief measures as are necessary to help children in need.
- 37. To Foster and develop natural love and affection amongst children and to take appropriate steps for the achievement of this objective.
- 38. To nurture develop the personality of children.
- 39. To open orphanages and other such institutions to rehabilitate orphans, destitutes and distressed.
- 40. To start mid-age asylums for accommodating the deserted old people for the expiation from their sense of insecurity.
- 41. To organize centres for social marriages for helping the poor unmarried people.
- 42. To start resort centres for the Deaf, Dumb, Blind and other crippled people.
- 43. To start all other types of humanitarian service centres. To start small scale Industries, factories and other useful institutions to provide employment opportunities to the needy poor and to eliminate poverty.
- 44. To establish construct, maintain, run, aid, develop, improve and extend dispensaries, hospitals and other centres for rendering medical aid and run institutions for improving the health of the public and /or for prevent on of diseases.
- 45. To open, establish, construct, maintain, run, develop, improve, extend and aid in the opening, establishment, construction, equipment, running, development and extension of research centres and research institutions meant for carrying out research, in medicine.
- 46. To take over and manage and run other schools and other institutions which are sick and not able to maintain by the persons or similar trusts.
- 47. To perform Cultural Programmes in India and Abroad for promoting Indian Cultural and to raise funds for benefits of the Trust.
- 48. To acquire/take over all the assets and liabilities of any business/societies and to run the same for the welfare of public.

29. To do any business in India Export, Import any commodities/bonds for the benefits of destitute, widow and to spend the profit or the business for the welfare of the poor.

30. Work for the upliftment and welfare of minority community people in particular in the Union Territory of Pondicherry to subserve the interest of the persons having knowledge of Telugu and Telugu speaking minority people / students in the Union Territory of Pondicherry, in the matter of providing / promoting education including higher education in Engineering Medical and other disciplines, so that the educational institutions established and to be established by the trust and being administered by the trust so much is entitled to give preference to Telugu speaking minority students in the Union Territory of Pondicherry.

31. The objects mentioned above shall be independent of each other and the Board of Trustees are hereinafter constituted may from time to time, apply the funds of the Trust in carrying out all or any of the aforesaid objects of the trust as it may in its absolute discretion, deem fit.

#### IV. MANAGING TRUSTEE:

The First Managing Trustee of the Trust shall be Mr. J. SHOVINDAR. The Managing Trustees shall hold office for life or at will, the Managing Trustee can resign from the Managing Trusteeship of the trust by submitting a letter of resignation. The Managing Trustee shall be the right to appoint or nominate any one of his heirs or any other person as Managing Trustee in his place, who shall hold office for life at will. Such appointed or nominated Managing Trustee shall also have the right to appoint or nominate another Managing Trustee in his place and so on. This right to appointing or nominating the Successor Managing Trustee vested in the present Managing Trustee-holding office for the time being shall be absolute unless the said Managing Trustee having such power of appointment or nomination relinquishes such right expressly in writing.

#### V. POWERS AND DUTIES OF MANAGING TRUSTEE:

1. All the properties, funds and assets of the trust shall vest in the Managing Trustee and they shall be in complete management of the affairs of the Trust.

2. The Managing Trustee of the Trust shall have the power of administration, employment, removal of employees etc., A Secretary may be appointed by the Managing Trustee to look after the day to day administration of the trust under the supervision and control of Managing Trustee of the Trust.

3. The Managing Trustee's may meet for the dispatch of business, adhoc and otherwise regulate their meetings, as they think fit. The Managing Trustee shall summon meetings of the Managing Trustee. The Managing Trustee shall be entitled to exercise one additional casting vote in the event of equity of votes.

4. The Managing Trustees shall have power to augment the funds of the Trust from any source by accepting donations, voluntary contributions of any kind if they think such acceptance is in the interests of the Trust.

5. Without prejudice to the above such general powers the Managing Trustees shall have powers:-

a) to buy, sell, negotiate and enter into contracts, passing and vary such contracts, make advances upon and pay for the purchase of all material, stores, machinery and other goods required.

b) to purchase land and buildings and maintain and keep up lands, buildings, equipment and materials and to sell, mortgage or dispose of all or any of the same as the Managing Trustees may think fit.

c) to execute, become party to, sign acknowledge, perfect and register all deeds, agreements and to give effectual discharge in behalf of the Trust.

d) to borrow from time to time such sums of moneys for such period on such terms with or without security as the Managing Trustees may think fit.

e) to draw, make accept, endorse, discount, negotiate, execute and issue promissory notes, bill of exchange, hundies, cheques, Government and other securities and other negotiable instruments.

f) to initiate, conduct, defend, compound, withdraw, compromise, adjudge, refer to arbitration or abandon any legal or other proceedings, claims or disputes its officers or employees concerning the affairs of the trust and to sign and verify Vakalatn, Plaints, Statements, Execution, Petitions, Affidavits and other proceedings.

g) to open and close accounts with Banks, to operate upon any such accounts to pay and draw money from such accounts and otherwise deal with the same and the powers in this behalf may be exercised by the Managing Trustees or by any other Trustees empowered by a resolution of the Trustees in a meeting held under the Presidency of the Managing Trustees.

h) to insure and keep insured, if deemed expedient, all or any of the buildings and other assets of the Trust.

i) Generally to carry out transactions as they consider expedient in the interest of the Trust and to make all such arrangements and do such acts and things on behalf of the Trust as may be usual, necessary desirable or expedient for the Management of the affairs of the Trust or in carrying out its objects.

j) to invest the funds of the Trust only in any investments authorized under the provisions of the Income-Tax Act and other Direct Tax Acts which will enable the Trust to avail the exemption available thereunder.

h) The Trustee is authorized to borrow money for the purpose of the Trust from Banks, Financial institutions and others with or without security and in respect of any other assets both movable and immovable belonging to the Managing Trustee security and ensure under the need of agreement or deed or mortgage for the purpose of offering the assets of the Trust as security in respect of such borrowings.

i) The Managing Trustee is entitled to mortgage the funds and moneys and other assets of the trust in any immovable properties so far as may be necessary from time to time and have the right to sell, lease, mortgage or dispose of such assets and immovable properties so far as may be found necessary in this behalf or approval of the Trust Board and any such documents/contracts shall be signed by the Managing Trustee.

j) The Managing Trustee is authorized to acquire by purchase or by lease, land, buildings, agricultural lands and other properties for the purpose of the objects of the Trust. The Managing Trustee or Managing Trustees are authorized to construct on own land or leased land, superstructure for the purpose of the object of the Trust and for the said purpose all the documents shall be signed by the Managing Trustee.

k) In delegata by powers of attorney or by a resolution passed in this behalf or otherwise any of the powers herein above specified, to any Managing Trustee or Trustees or any other person or persons for effectually and smoothly carrying out the objects of the Trust and for proper administration of the Trust.

l) The Trustee is entitled to make rules for the purposes of the objects of the Trust, but such rules shall not be against the objects of the Trust as stated above. The amendment to any clause of this Trust deed shall be carried out only with the approval of the Managing Trustee, subject to the provisions of law.

m) The Trust is entitled to collect fees for the purpose of the objects of the Trust.

n) To collect donations, gifts in cash or kind from registered bodies or firms, limited company or from Govt. either by aids or trust or getting lands by donations or by assignments or for long lease and other general public irrespective of caste religion, sex etc and use the same towards fulfilling aims and objects of the trust.

o) To raise/borrow from time to time such one or sums of money at such interest for such period and on such terms with or without security movable or immovable as the management think fit or secure payments of with interest by mortgage of the trust properties.

p) The Managing Trustee by a majority decision may appoint, nominate, elect, or co-opt any lawfully eligible person as the Managing Trustee/Trustees of the said Trust.

5) The Managing Trustees by a majority decision may remove, suspend, any person recommended by the Managing Trustee from the Trusteeship of the Trust for breach of Trust mis-conduct, mis-representation, mis-appropriation of the Trust property or such other covert or covert conduct, activity of behaviour which the Managing Trustee deem to be against the interest of the Trust.

#### VI. ASSETS OF THE TRUST:

The Trust assets shall comprise of all funds received as donations whether as corpus fund or otherwise, all income the investment, movable and immovable properties acquired by gift, purchase, lease or otherwise and all the properties shall be held either in the name of the Trust or in the name of the Managing Trustee or two of the Trustees as the circumstances may require.

#### VII. ACCOUNTS:

1) The accounts of the Trust shall be closed every in 31st March and Income and Expenditure account and Balance Sheet as on that date shall be prepared. The surplus fund if not applied within the year of account shall be accumulated for any specific object of the Trust and invested in any manner authorized under the Income Tax for the year being.

2) " The Managing Trustee shall have power to frame from time to time rules from the proper conduct of the affairs of the Trust and alter, amend, vary, rescind, annual any of the clauses or rules of the ORIGINAL DEED or SUPPLEMENTARY DEED OF DECLARATION OF TRUST. Also the Managing Trustee have the power to a amend, alter, vary, rescind, annual any of the powers vested in the Managing Trustee by the ORIGINAL DEED or SUPPLEMENTARY DEED OF DECLARATION OF TRUST. The Managing Trustee shall not have any power to amend any of the objects of the Trust unless such amendments are in consonance with the main objects of the trust".

3) The accounts of the trust shall be audited every year by qualified Chartered Accountant/s.

#### VIII. GENERAL:

1) This Trust shall be irrevocable.

2) The Income of the funds of the Trust shall be solely utilized towards its objects and no portion of it shall be utilized for the payment to Trustees by way of profit, interest, dividend etc,

3) The benefits of the trust are open to all persons irrespective of Caste, Religion, Sex etc,

4) The Trust shall not carry on any activity with the intention of earning profit.

5) The following persons are additionally appointed as appointed trustees for efficient management advised and to assist in the management of the trust to achieve the objects of the Trust:

6) The three-fourth of the majority of the Trustees may remove any trustee from the office of trusteeship of the Trust and upon such removal he/she shall be bound to vacate the office of trusteeship and handover the property or records of the Trust to the remaining trustees.

7) If and whenever the number of the Trustees shall be reduced below three, including Managing Trustee the remaining trustee shall appoint with the approval of the Managing Trustee such number of new Trustees as they think fit, so however that the number of Trustees shall not exceed five.
